

INTRAMURAL STUDIES

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Pursuant to the Regulation of the Minister of National Education and Sports of 13 June 2003 amending the regulation setting the teaching standards for individual courses of study and instruction levels, the vocational study of tourism and recreation takes at least 3 years (6 semesters). The total number of classes is approx. 2200, of which 1200 classes are specified in the teaching standards.
2. At the College of Tourism and Recreation, the total number of classes in full-time courses amounts from 2116 to 2202.
The number of classes relating to the subjects that are deemed to make up a teaching standard is as follows:
 - a. in the Tourism Organisation and Handling major: 1937.
 - b. in the Sports and Recreation Management major: 1924.
 - c. in the Hospitality and Catering major: 1964.
